his robe filled the temple.**



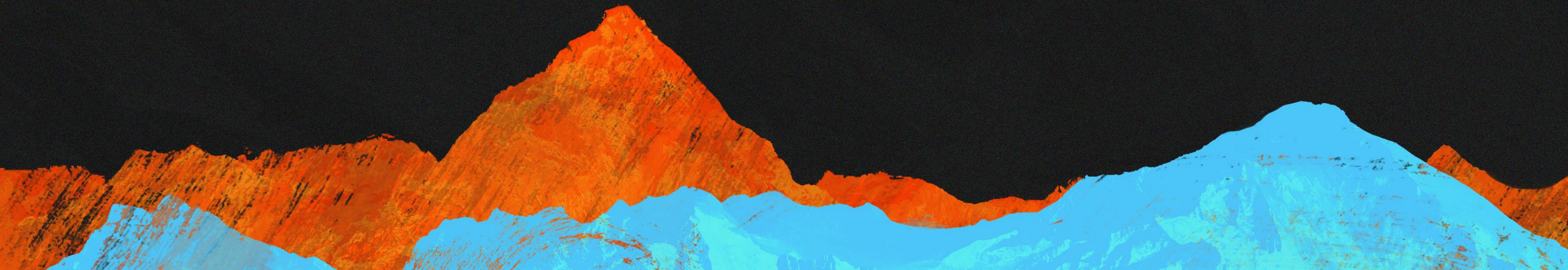
Who was King Uzziah?

He reigned for 52 years. He led Judah to victories against enemies.

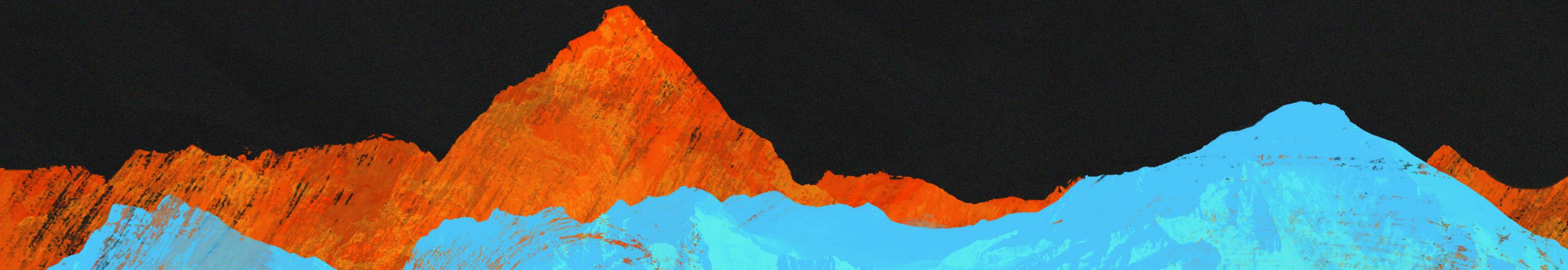
He was smart and innovative leader. Judah was enjoying peace, stability and prosperity during his reign.

hardship, crisis, and difficulty?**

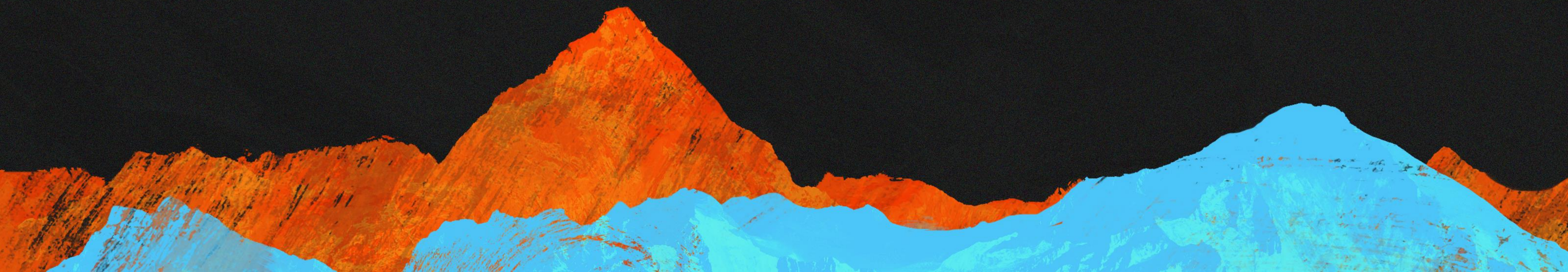

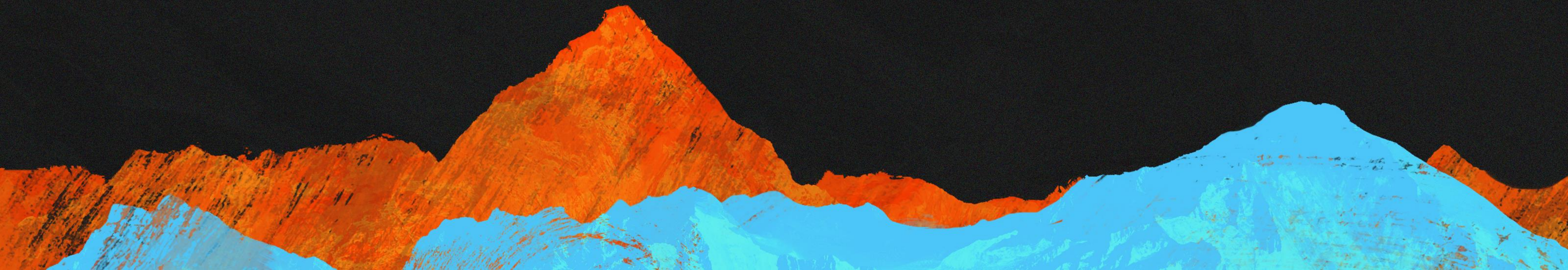

Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.

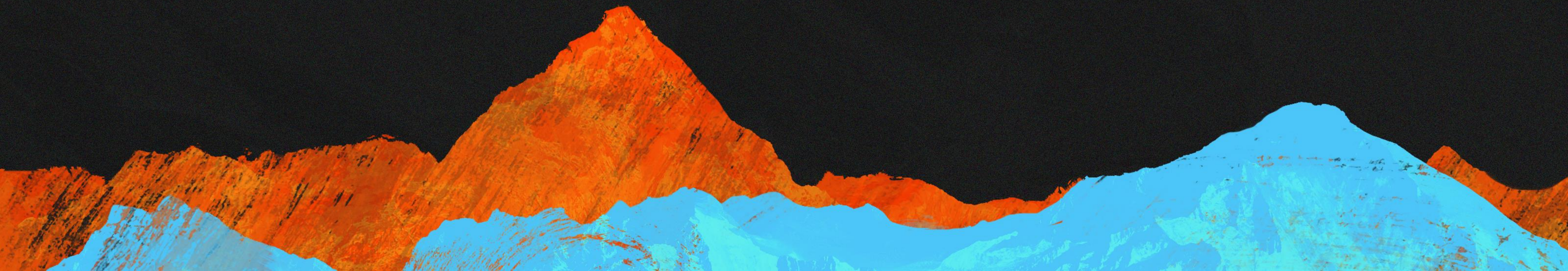

And he touched my mouth and said: “Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for.”

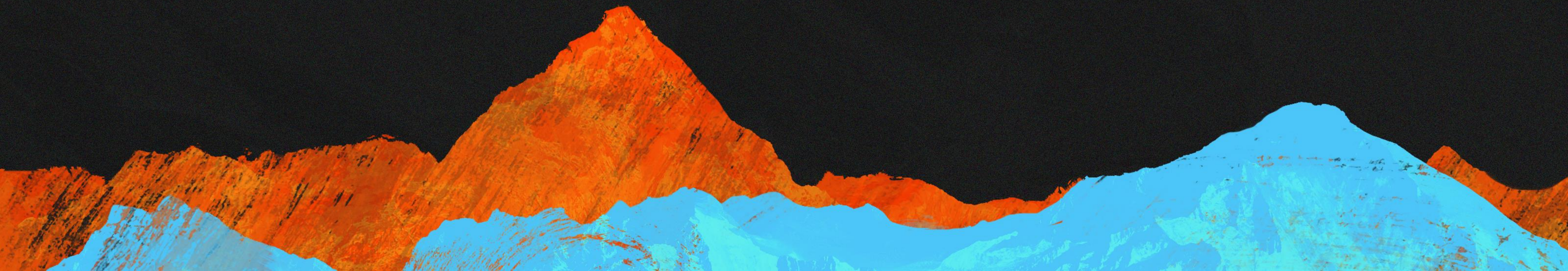
