He was smart and innovative leader. Judah was enjoying peace, stability and prosperity during his reign.



What do you do when a nation's leader has failed or disappointed its citizen?


What do you do when all you see is hardship, crisis, and difficulty?

CHANGE OF PERSPECTIVE




Isaiah 6:2 ESV

Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.


Isaiah 6:3 Esv

And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke.


Isaiah 6:5 ESV


"When we see God, we also see our sinfulness. We see his righteousness and we see how wicked we are."

Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar.


Isaiah 6:7 ESV
