Genesis 13:5 (NIV)

5 Now Lot, who was moving about with Abram, also had flocks and herds and tents.

Genesis 19:15–16 (NIV)

15 With the coming of dawn, the angels urged Lot, saying, "Hurry! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away when the city is punished." 16 When he hesitated, the men grasped his hand and the hands of his wife and of his two daughters and led them safely out of the city, for the Lord was merciful to them.

Genesis 19:29 (NIV)

29 So when God destroyed the cities of the plain, he remembered Abraham, and he brought Lot out of the catastrophe that overthrew the cities where Lot had lived.

YOUR CHOICES Can affect Your CHILDREN and THE NEXT GENERATION

Genesis 19:31–32 (NIV)

31 One day the older daughter said to the younger, "Our father is old, and there is no man around here to give us children—as is the custom all over the earth. 32 Let's get our father to drink wine and then sleep with him and preserve our family line through our father."

Mark 8:34 (NIV)

36 So both of Lot's daughters became pregnant by their father. 37 The older daughter had a son, and she named him Moab; he is the father of the <u>Moabites</u> of today. 38 The younger daughter also had a son, and she named him Ben-Ammi; he is the father of the <u>Ammonites</u> of today.
