




ENCOURAGE one another.

ADMONISH one another.


And we urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with them all.

... Speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ...








PRAY one another.


