







Today, we will look at what it means to be in church community while we wait for Christ's glorious return

But we were gentle among you, like a nursing mother taking care of her own children.




Serving in View of Christ's Coming caring for each other, encouraging each other, and charging each each other to follow God.




Point #2

1 THESSALONIANS 2:8




Serving in View of Christ's Coming sharing our whole selves and lives with each other.




Point #3
