LOVE

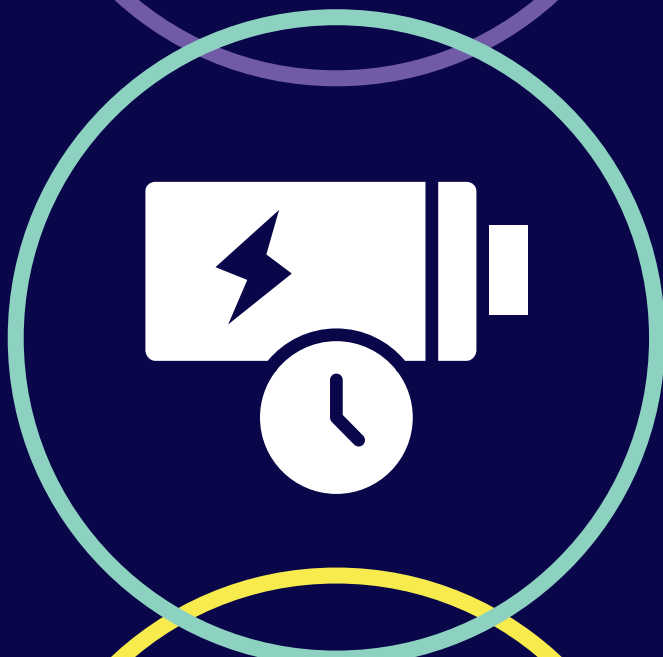
Pray their love for one another will be grounded on Christ's love for us. Pray they resolve conflicts Biblically. Pray they are peacemakers.

LOOK BACK

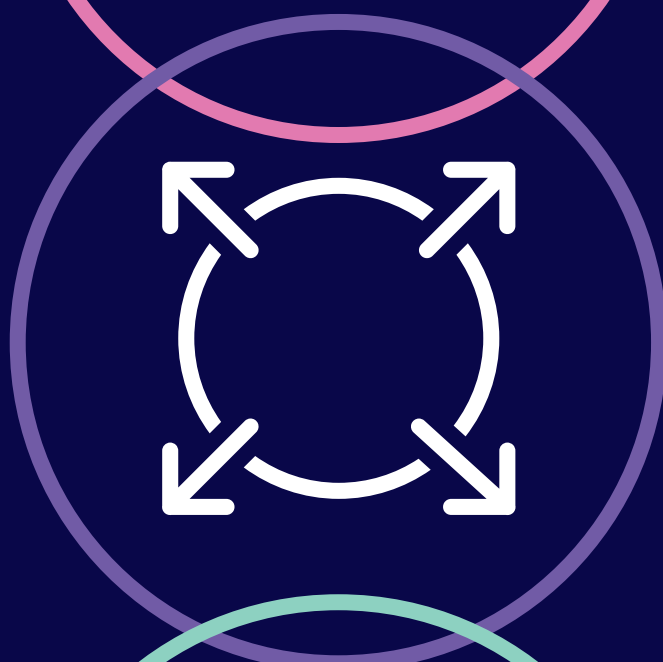
Reflect on what God has done and express gratitude. What past prayers has He answered? What impossible situations have now become possible?

LOOK OUT

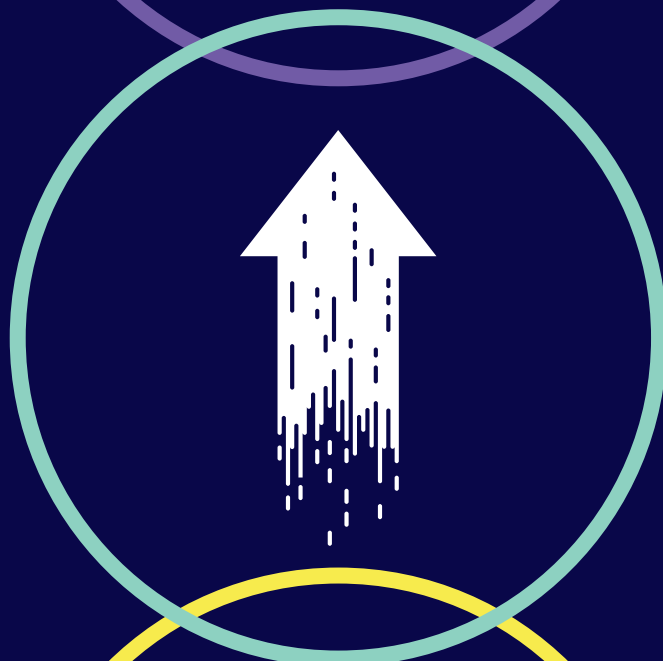
Observe what God is currently doing and offer praise, boasting in His work. Is there anyone whose faith the Lord has grown? Give them encouragement today.

LOOK UP

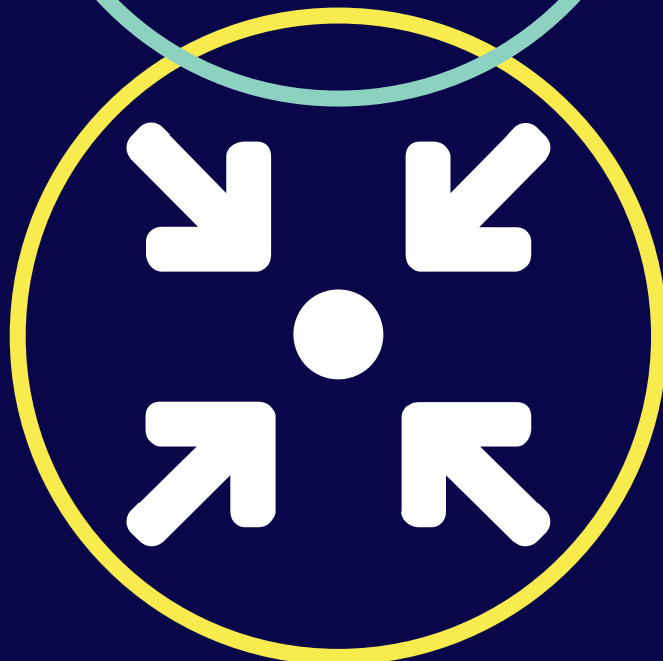
Turn to God as your source of strength, making your requests known to Him. Remember prayer's power isn't in a formula but a person, Jesus Christ.

LOOK IN

Examine your heart and motivations, ensuring your prayers are driven ONLY by a desire for God's glory. Is this prayer according to His will, for His glory, in His name?



2 THESSALONIANS 1:3-4; 11-12

We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing. Therefore, among God's churches we boast about your perseverance and faith in all the persecutions and trials you are enduring....With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith. 12 We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
